How Windy Row Works with Teachers

Teachers and Windy Row work together in many ways.

First, most of our tutors were or are teachers. They've also undergone intense training at Windy Row—on their own time—to learn our specialized one-on-one tutoring techniques for children who are falling behind grade level in reading and math.

Second, we go beyond testing to talk directly with teachers (and parents) about the child's struggles and how we can best adapt our tutoring.

Third, we are in the midst of planning a 2-hour program to take

information about dyslexia, dyscalculia and other reading/math challenges to the teachers, offering Continuing Education Credits for attendance. We want to help teachers recognize reading and math challenges *before* children begin to fail.

Finally, we have the only summer program in the entire region for children with moderate to severe reading and math challenges. Teachers know that children will return to school with even stronger skills after attending Windy Row Learning Center.

Scholarships & Financial Aid at Windy Row

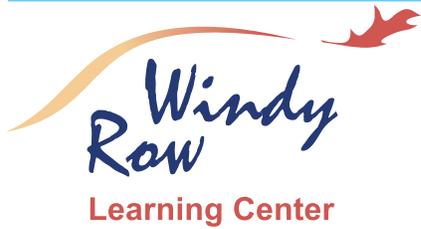
Part of Windy Row's mission is to make sure that every child who needs our help gets it.
