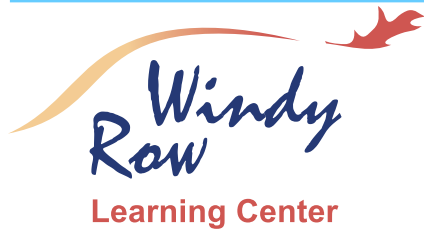
\$1000 from the **Masonic Lodge**, Altmont #26 and \$2,500 from the **People's United Community Fund**.

an important role in funding Windy Row. Thank you for your support of our Annual Appeal—now and in the future. Every donation brings a child closer to the gift of reading!

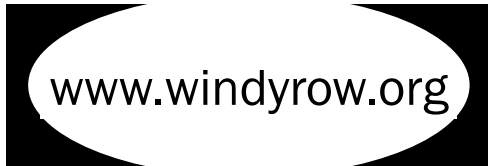
