When Good Enough Isn't Good Enough



A Windy Row parent came to us because of a comment her son's third-grade teacher had written on a school paper.

Every sentence on the paper was marked with corrections. Like many children with reading challenges, her son has difficulty in writing thoughts down on paper and difficulty with handwriting, since both skills require seeing the correlation between the shapes of letters and their sounds.

In any case, the teacher had covered the boy's paper with corrections. And at the very top, the teacher wrote, "okay for his ability."

At Windy Row, children find a resource that helps take them beyond the limits of just "okay."

Parents come to us from public school, private school and home school situations because we are specialists in giving children the techniques they need to overcome difficulties in reading

and math. We are dedicated to that task.

During a school year of tutoring at Windy Row, children progress one, two or even three grade levels in reading skills, whereas before they were falling further and further behind their peers. Their progress delights everyone, tutors, parents, teachers—and especially the children themselves.
